Metro wishes there was a cookie-cutter policy that could make everything easy all the time, but that's not possible. Bringing strollers and carts on Metro buses is difficult for everyone. We need to consider each boarding on a case-by-case basis, always keeping a few things in mind -



Respect each other. We're all in this together.



Strollers and carts are always welcome on Metro buses.



Strollers and carts should be folded and out of the way. This may mean removing a child or packages.



You can put strollers or carts in the areas designated for the disabled or elderly if - and only if - they are not needed by the disabled or elderly.



Strollers and carts may not fit on a bus if the bus is full. This is never our first choice, but an operator may ask you to wait for the next bus.

This will work, if we all work together.
